Camp Focus

Summer Strings is a week-long chamber music camp for intermediate and advanced string players. Students will have the opportunity to study, rehearse and perform great works from the chamber music repertoire in a fun and relaxed setting. Daily sessions will include group rehearsals and sectionals as well as supervised individual practice. Coached rehearsals will provide instruction on the musical background and appropriate performance style and technique of each piece. The emphasis of Summer Strings is on fostering excellence and a love for ensemble playing, culminating in a concert on the final day. Join us and share your joy in making music with friends!



Application Requirements

Registration is open to any string player at intermediate level or higher. Students are expected to have good shifting, intonation and music reading skills. Admitted students will receive sheet music and a CD in May and are required to prepare the music by the first day of camp, allowing the group to focus on making music as an ensemble.

Music Selections

During the week the group will be intensively focusing on two main pieces: "Miniature Concerto" by Robin Milford and Corelli's "Christmas" Concerto Grosso. Shorter pieces will be used for warm up and fun group activities. In order for every player to have the most positive musical experience, it will be very important for all participants to know their individual parts well. In this manner, music can be made by all!
